

A New Exciting Way to Get Contacts for the Ministry

I have developed a grief outreach ministry. This is how it works: We have partnered with the funeral homes in our area, they give us the names of those who have lost loved ones, and we then send them a series of five newsletters on how to deal with grief. After the fifth newsletter, we go by the bereaved house and share the Gospel. The newsletters prepare and plant the seed. You can advertise the funeral home on the newsletter, and the funeral home can pay for some of the postage, which it costs to send the letters. I have the newsletters, and would like to share them with any fundamental Bible believing Pastor. I will even customize them for each church as long as the church credits me for writing them. As long as your copier will print 11 by 17 papers, all you have to do is copy them. Here is the first newsletter in PDF form. Let me know if you're interested.

Note: If the funeral homes in your area will not work with you, all you have to do is just go to their websites, find the names of the immediate family of the deceased, and look up the information in the phone book or 411locate.com. Add a personal letter in the first issue, telling them you saw that they had recently lost a loved one and would like to send them these newsletters. This is a great ministry for the seniors.
